Rehearsals

Our first rehearsal will take place on **Saturday 6th September**. Rehearsals take place in the Theatre Area please use Door 7 to access the building. Instrument cases should be left in Room 27 ('the blue room').

Rehearsals start at 9.15am, so please ensure that you are in your seat, warmed up and ready to start playing at that time. Between 10.00am and 11.00am, we are fortunate to have Mr Butler with us to support our percussion team and we then have a 15-minute break, from 11.00-11.15am. Rehearsals finish at 12.15pm. Please help to tidy away chairs and stands at the end of rehearsal. Our percussionists will always appreciate anyone willing to lend a hand in moving the instruments back into the percussion room!

Please ensure that you bring your music and a pencil with you to all rehearsals. Jason, our librarian, works hard to ensure that all members have their own copy of each piece we play, and writing things on your music will be invaluable when practising at home.

Access to the NMPAT building is controlled by a keypad. The code was included in the email to which this letter was attached. Please do not share this code with anyone, and, although it's tempting to be polite, try to avoid holding the door open for anyone that isn't in your group.

Please try to tell us in advance if you know you are not able to attend a rehearsal for any reason. The easiest way to do this is online, via iPresto. You can also email me using the details below, or contact the main office on 01604 637117. We take online registers for all County Ensembles, using iPresto. This means that an automatically generated email will be sent home if you are not at a rehearsal and we don't already know that you are going to be absent.
