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Brass, Strings, Woodwind

String Sinfonia - experience and an instrument needed for this class. **Bronze medal minimum**

Wind Band - for woodwind, recorder and brass instruments, includes advanced guitarists. **5 notes minimum**

Jazz & Improvisation - wide ranging repertoire – modern and traditional, for drum, guitar, piano wind and brass players. **Grade 1 minimum**

Ska - covering music from Madness, The Specials and more, for drum, guitar, piano wind and brass players. **Grade 1 minimum**

Brass Ensemble - all brass instruments. **Copper Music Medal minimum**

Woodwind Ensemble - all woodwind instruments incl. recorder. **Copper Music Medal minimum**

Holloway Pop Orchestra – wide ranging repertoire - all instruments welcome. **All standards welcome**

N.B. Students will need to bring an instrument for the strings, wind, brass classes. We can provide ukuleles, keyboards and percussion. It is recommended that pupils have their own guitar as we have a limited number to borrow.

Guitar, Ukulele

Fiddle Fiesta - for strings players, guitars, and ukuleles. **All standards welcome**

Beginner Guitar and Ukulele - Ukuleles provided – although your own is preferred. Own guitar needed for both Beginner classes.

Fiddlesticks - for beginner string players. **Bumblebees upwards. All standards welcome**

Folk & Global Music - a variety of Folk Genres are explored, any instruments welcome. **Grade 1 upwards**

Art, General Musicianship, Choir, Keyboards

Arts & Crafts - a variety of artistic projects and topics. **Open to everyone from Bumblebees upwards**

General Musicianship (GM) Music theory using games, worksheets and whole class activities. **All standards welcome**

Keyboards All standards welcome, limited spaces available.

Holloway Voices – lots and lots of singing! **Open to everyone**

Dance, Drama – open to everyone

Drama – session 1, Monologues, Duologues, Musical Theatre solos.

Drama Skills - voice projection, stage work, poetry, Shakespeare, plus games and activities to develop confidence.

Musical Theatre – the MT class explores dancing, singing and drama - engage your “High School Musical” vibes in this class!

Explore Percussion - explore a range of percussion instruments and try creating your own - saucepans, plastic bottles and more. Bring it all along and get creative. (Might also include Boomwhackers). **No experience needed**

Ready Steady Glock - tuned percussion, glocks provided. **No experience needed**

Global Percussion - African drumming, Samba and much more. **All standards welcome**

Rock Band - explores a variety of Rock & Pop charts and music, beginner, training and senior classes available to cover all levels/abilities. Keyboards, guitars and singers all welcome.
