## Suitable for beginners with an instrument

- **Training Orchestra** First steps in orchestra playing for wind, brass, strings and percussion. **Grades 0-2+**

## Some experience required

- **Guitar Ensemble** Suitable for all levels of guitarists. Playing a mixture of styles. Any type of guitar welcome (must have your own).
