Rehearsals

Our rehearsals take place on Tuesday evenings, in Room 27, from 6.00-7.15pm. Room 27 is found through Door 7, where there is also a waiting room if you arrive early. Our first rehearsal will be on **Tuesday 9th September**.

Access to the NMPAT building is controlled by a keypad. The code was included in the email to which this letter was attached. Please do not share this code with anyone, and, although it's tempting to be polite, try to avoid holding the door open for anyone that isn't in your group.

Please try to tell us in advance if you know you are not able to attend a rehearsal for any reason. The easiest way to do this is online, via iPresto. You can also email me using the details below, or contact the main office on 01604 637117. We take online registers for all County Ensembles, using iPresto. This means that an automatically generated email will be sent home if you are not at a rehearsal and we don't already know that you are going to be absent.

Open evening

Before County Ensemble rehearsals recommence, you are invited to the NMPAT open evening. This is an opportunity to re-familiarise yourself with the building, and make sure you know where to go before your first rehearsal. If you've been attending NMPAT for a long time, you may feel comfortable supporting younger students on their first open evening – please let us know if you would like to help show new families around (office@nmpat.co.uk)

Concert dress: we perform in all black, including clean black shoes. Please avoid jeans and any skirts should be at or below knee length, and worn with black tights.
