### Rehearsals

Rehearsals take place on Saturdays during term time, in the Richard Coles Hall at NMPAT. This is found through Door 1 and along the corridor. We start at 9.00am so please arrive in plenty of time to warm up and be ready to play. We finish at 12.00noon and there will be a short break – you may wish to bring some money for the tuck shop.

Usually, we will start the morning in sectional rehearsals, using the rooms detailed below.

Access to the NMPAT building is controlled by a keypad. The code was included in the email to which this letter was attached. Please do not share this code with anyone, and, although it's tempting to be polite, try to avoid holding the door open for anyone that isn't in your group.

Please try to tell us in advance if you know you are not able to attend a rehearsal for any reason. The easiest way to do this is online, via iPresto. You can also email us using the details at the end of this letter, or contact the main office on 01604 637117. We take online registers for all County Ensembles, using iPresto. This means that an automatically generated email will be sent home if you are not at a rehearsal and we don't already know that you are going to be absent.

### Open evening

Before our first rehearsal, you are invited to come to the NMPAT open evening. Particularly if you are in a moving to a new group this year, you may like to familiarise yourself with a different part of the building before your first rehearsal. Anyone is welcome – families included – anytime from 4.00-6.00pm, on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> September**.
