**Arrival:** Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the start of your rehearsal, detailed below. Changing facilities are limited so we recommend that you arrive in your concert dress. NMPAT staff will be on hand to show you into the church and where you can leave your cases etc.

**During the concert:** All students will be able to sit and watch the other groups performing. Students will be supervised by NMPAT staff for the duration of their time on site.

**After rehearsals:** We recommend you bring a packed tea / snack and students will be supervised by staff for the duration of their time at the Church. Students in youth groups may leave the site if required, and students in training groups must have written permission from a parent / carer. Students who choose to leave the church will not be supervised by NMPAT staff – we recommend you

stay in groups of at least 3 and take extra care crossing roads. Please email your director in advance of the concert or bring a note on the day, if you intend to go off site.

All students need to be back on site, in concert dress, by 6:30pm.
